THE OLD PEOPLE OF LYONS

Brief Biographies

Something About the Old People With Whom We are Acquainted. Their Lives and Reminiscences

Believing that the biographies of the old people of Lyons would be of interest to many of our readers, The Sun is now preparing a series for publication. The first one which we introduce this week is that of Josiah Austin, and [sic] aged and honorable man, much respected in our community.

Josiah Austin was born in Washington county, New York on the 7th [sic -- 17th] of December, 1814. When two years old he moved with his parents to Livingstone [sic -- Livingston] county, where he lived until after his marriage. His education was obtained like that of all men in those days in the rude log school house where the school master was generally more proficient in wielding the birch, than he was in reading, writing and arithmetic.

Mr. Austin resided in Livingstone county until after his marriage which occurred at the early age of nineteen, the exact date being the 31st of December, 1833. Miss Arbella [sic -- Arvilla] Barnum was the blushing bride, and though perhaps their prospects might not have been as bright as some, surrounded as they were by a newly settled and heavily timbered country, yet they were no doubt happy and looked forward to a lifelong companionship which by the goodness of God, has been richly blessed and continuous for sixty years.

Mr. Austin and his wife removed to Henry county, Ohio, in the fall of 1842 and was a resident of the county for fourteen years. Here all his children except one were born. They are six in number, all living and enjoying a goodly degree of happiness. There are four girls and two boys as follows:

The eldest is Sarah, wife of Peter Wood and a resident of this city. The second, Nancy, is the wife of Russel Embury, of Rice county, Minnesota, the third, Matilda, wife of Milton Tomlinson, of Seattle, Washington, the fourth, Mary, wife of Frank Farnham [sic -- Farnam], also of this place. The first son, Josiah, is a traveling solicitor with headquarters in Sioux City, the youngest, Theodore, is a resident of Fairbault [sic -- Faribault], Minnesota, and a carpenter by trade.

Though eighty years and more have frosted the head of Josiah Austin, yet he retains his faculties and possesses an exceptionally good memory. He is of powerful build and today is straight as an arrow. In his younger days few were his equal in physical strength and in the performance of manual labor where strength and endurance were required, he never allowed himself to be outdone. Whether it was in the wheatfield with the old fashioned cradle, in the hayfield swinging the scythe or with his ax in the forest, he reckoned himself equal to any in his neighborhood, and none will doubt that it was so.

His recollection of the presidents extends back to that of John Quincy Adams whose term of office endured from 1817 to 1825 [sic -- 1825-1829], but the first presidential campaign of which he has distinct recollection was that of William Henry Harrison [1840] who lived in a log house at the time of his election and whose diet, according to his opponents, was hard cider and raccoon meat. He remembers distinctly of the first telegraph message [1844] and of the "hair-brained [sic -- harebrained] Morse" as he was termed who was so presumptuous [sic] as to believe that two persons could communicate with each other at a distance by wire and electricity.

Mr. Austin has lived in the good old democratic times of which we hear much in these days.

The wages prevailing in his early manhood was 50 cents per day except in haying when \$1.00 or \$1.50 might be secured. The third year after Mr. Austin was married he worked for \$12 per month and supported his family.

Wheat brought \$2 per bushel in that timbered country. All clothing was made by hand. Mrs. Austin was expert at spinning and his sister had a loom where they wove the cloth. Mr. Austin says that they have cloth in the house at the present time which wife and sister manufactured in those early days. Notwithstanding the low wages all necessities of life were extremely high. Heavy boots cost from \$2.50 to \$3.00 and a better grade \$4.00, and other things in proportion.

Among other reminiscences Mr. Austin recalls distinctly the William Morgan episode [1826] which will be remembered by many of the older people. Morgan was a Mason and becoming dissatisfied with the

organization he wrote a pamphlet exposing the secrets of the order. He was arrested on a trumped up charge and imprisoned in the Canandaigua [Ontario Co.], N. Y., jail. Subsequently he was taken from the jail but he was never heard of or seen again. The supposition was that he was drowned in lake Erie or sent over Niagara falls. The men who abducted Morgan were arrested and on trail for years but nothing was ever proved against them. The incident, however revolutionized politics and for years no man could be elected to the most trivial [sic] office unless he publicly renounced Masonry. Mr. Austin was at one time shown the team that carried Morgan away.

Mr. Austin was not a soldier but his grand-father served seven years in the revolutionary war and his father was a veteran of 1812.

In 1856 Mr. Austin removed with his family to Rice county, Minnesota where he has resided until his removal to Lyons about two years ago [April 1894]. His life has been one of hard work on the farm, up to the time of his removal to Lyons, but owing to his advanced age it was decided to buy a home near his eldest daughter [Sarah] where his remaining days could be spent in quiet, as becomes one who has honorably earned his rest.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Austin are earnest Christian people whom it is a pleasure to know. The record of their lives furnishes a hundred amusing incidents which cannot be told in this brief space, but which may be brought out in conversation with them.

Obituary of Josiah Austin, Lyons Mirror, 16 Feb. 1899, copy in Records of Richard R. Wilson, Clyde Hill, WA:

DIED Josiah Austin at his home in Lyons at 10 o'clock Thursday morning, Feb. 9, 1899, aged 84 years 1 month and 23 days [= b.d. 17 Dec. 1814].

The deceased was born at Cambridge N. Y. Dec. 17, 1814, where he resided until he was two years old when his parent [sic], moved to Washington county [sic -- Livingston Co.] in the same state.

On Dec. 31, 1833 was married to Miss Arvilla Barnum and they lived there until the fall of 1842 when they moved to Henry Co. Ohio. Lived there until spring of 1856 when they removed to Fairbault [sic -- Faribault] Minn. arriving there July 20, 1856. Came to Lyons in April 1894 where he resided until his death. All his children except one were born in Ohio. His children are: Sarah F. wife of Peter Wood, of Lyons; Nancy, wife of Russel Emberry [sic], Fairbault, Minn., Matilda, wife of Milton Temlinson of Seattle, Wash.; Mary, wife of Frank Farnam of this place; Franklin Austin of Charles City, Iowa; Theodore Austin, of Fairbault, Minn.

The funeral services were held at the Methodist church Saturday at 1 p.m. conducted by Rev. Bethwell and the remains were interred in the Lyons cemetery. The pall bearers were: Wm. Waite, J. Shumway, Oliver Waite, D. Cowerman, J. D. Niven, and C. Van Schaeck.

Theodore the youngest son arrived here Friday to attend the funeral, the other children being unable to attend. He had twelve grand children and two great grand children.

Mr. Austin was an honorable man among men the noblest of human character and he surely climbed to the highest and richest rewards that come to the blest of earth in the everlasting realms of the Great beyond.

Former Resident of Lyons Succumbs

Local relatives and friends of Mrs. Sarah Wood, a former resident of Lyons, received word of her death which occurred at the home of her brother, Frank Austin, at Los Angeles, California, Tuesday, December 11.

Despite her advanced age of 91 years, she enjoyed good health and maintained all of her faculties. She attended church the Sunday before she succumbed and was only ill a day or so before her demise. Death was due to angina pectoris.

Mrs. Wood left Lyons 11 years ago to make her home with her brother in California. F.A. Farnam of Lyons is her nephew.

She leaves an adopted son D.E. Wood of Chicago, Illinois, one brother, Frank Austin of Los Angeles,

California, and a granddaughter Mrs. Harold Wilson of Los Angeles.

The funeral services were held Thursday, December 13, from the United Brethren Church at Santa Monica, California.

On her 91st birthday, November 24, she was an honored guest at a party given by Mrs. H.H. Heberly at Los Angeles. Seven of the guests present were over 70 years of age.

That God will comfort the young husband and friends in this hour of great bereavement is the prayer of many friends. The motherless babe [dau. Sarah Clements] yet lives, though it is not known how soon the light of its tender young life may go out. Should it live there are friends to watch over it and care for it, cherishing it as a token of remembrance from the dear departed.

As we close our forms at 3:30 p.m., the preparations for the funeral are being made and it is announced that the services will be held at the M. E. church on Saturday at 2 p.m.
